

# NOTICE OF TAX REVENUE INCREASE

The Johnson County Emergency Service District #1 conducted public hearings on September 4, 2018 and September 10, 2018 on a proposal to increase the total tax revenues of the Johnson County Emergency Service District #1 from properties on the tax roll in the preceding year by 6.55 percent.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised last year at last year's tax rate of \$0.060000 for each \$100 of taxable value was \$3,717,149.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised this year at the proposed tax rate of \$0.060000 for each \$100 of taxable value, excluding tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year, is \$3,949,037.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised this year at the proposed tax rate of \$0.060000 for each \$100 of taxable value, including tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year, is \$4,049,161.

The Commissioners of Johnson County Emergency Service District #1 is scheduled to vote on the tax rate that will result in that tax increase at a public meeting to be held on September 19, 2018 at Johnson County ESD1, 2451 Service Drive, Cleburne, TX 76033 at 7:00 pm.

The Commissioners of Johnson County Emergency Service District #1 proposes to use the increase in total tax revenue for the purpose of continued fire protection.
